

Glenview Cottage Details

Situated in the small rural hamlet of Achmore in Ross-shire, and surrounded by natural woodland and pine forests, Glenview Cottage enjoys uninterrupted views of largely unspoilt natural habitat rich in wildlife. With plenty to see and do for all the family, Glenviews' location is ideal as a walking or touring base.

Accommodation

Glenview offers accommodation for up to 6 people and has a large off road parking area adjacent to the cottage. There are 2 double bedrooms and 1 twin bedded room all with fitted wardrobes and wash hand basins. There is a large bathroom with bath, separate shower and a heated towel rail. The kitchen is fully fitted and includes microwave, washing machine, cooker and fridge/freezer. Access to a tumble dryer can be provided.



The lounge/dining area is comfortable and bright and has a TV with Sky Digital, DVD, and a portable radio/cassette/CD player for your entertainment. The cottage is heated throughout by total control heating and there is a wood effect fire in the lounge for that extra bit of cosiness. Towels and bed linen are provided. Outside there is a washing line and a table with bench seats.

Disabled Facilities

Glenview Cottage also has facilities for the disabled including an easy access ramp with landing point, railing and banister. Internally there are wide doorways, the bathroom is fitted with handrails and all light switches are at low level.

The 'tropical' village of Plockton with it's palm trees growing along the main street, is just 7 miles away. 11 miles away is the fishing town of Kyle of Lochalsh, with the road bridge to take you 'over the sea to Skye', and only 8 miles away is surely one of **the** most famous castles to be found in Scotland, Eilean Donan. Situated in one of the most beautiful and romantic settings, the castle has been used in many films over the years such as 'Braveheart' and 'Local Hero'

There are plenty of amenities in the area, golf, fishing, horse riding and even trips in a glass bottomed boat! In Kyle you can also enjoy the facilities of an indoor swimming pool at the Leisure centre but, if you just want to 'head for the hills' for a spot of walking or climbing and to take in the spectacular scenery, the Kintail, Cuillin and Torridon ranges are all practically on the doorstep!



When it comes to eating out, you will be spoilt for choice. There are a number of excellent award winning restaurants and pubs in the neighbouring villages, all serving some of the very best and freshest local produce and cooked to mouth-watering perfection! The local shops are well stocked for all your self-catering needs with post offices and banks at hand too.

The city of Inverness, the 'Capital of the Highlands' and gateway to Loch Ness, is approximately 70 miles away and offers extensive shopping, entertainment and leisure activities with Inverness airport close by.

Bookings & Payments

A non-refundable deposit of £50 per week booked, either via a crossed sterling cheque drawn on a UK bank, or through [PayPal](#) is required to secure your booking.

For payment by [PayPal](#), a link to the [PayPal](#) site will be e-mailed to you if your chosen week is free. Please contact us via the Enquiries page at www.glenview-cottage.co.uk for confirmation of availability.

Balance of payment is due six weeks prior to arrival date, but bookings made within six weeks of arrival date are payable in full at time of booking.

If you have given us your e-mail address, we will acknowledge all payments you make by that method, or by normal post.

Arrival & Departures

Glenview Cottage will be ready for you at 3pm (15:00hrs) and should be vacated by 10am (10:00hrs) on day of departure.

Access to Glenview Cottage

Glenview Cottage will only be available for your occupation after full payment has been received and cleared by our bank.

Cleaning

The property should be left clean and tidy on departure and, if you bring a pet, particular attention should be paid to removal of pet hairs.

Damages

All damages and losses should be reported prior to departure. Damages and losses may be charged for.

Cancellations

Should you have to cancel, every endeavour will be made to re-let Glenview. Your payment (less deposit) will be refunded if Glenview is subsequently re-let.

We are sorry but we have to advise you of extended conditions regarding smoking and pets but this has become necessary due to the very small number of inconsiderate people we have had stay at Glenview Cottage.

Smoking

Along with all enclosed public spaces in Scotland, smoking is **not** allowed in Glenview Cottage.

You may smoke in the Cottage grounds but please ensure smoke does not enter the Cottage, that all cigarette ends etc. are put in the outside bin when extinguished and care is taken to avoid fire.

Pets

We only allow one pet, details of which must be disclosed at the time of booking. Additional and/or undisclosed pets arriving with owners will only be allowed into Glenview Cottage at our discretion.

All we ask is that you respect these few simple, common sense requests:

- Please keep your pets off the furniture.
- Please exercise your pets outside the garden.
- Please remove pet hairs from carpets before you leave.
- Please don't leave your pets unattended in the cottage or the garden.
- Please do not allow pets in the bedrooms.

In addition, we also request that dogs should be kept on a lead within the property garden.

These requests are made to help ensure that the stay of future guests, who may have an allergy, is made more comfortable.

We reserve the right to charge, at our discretion, for any damage caused by any pet.

Failure to observe either of the smoking or pets conditions may result in you being asked to prematurely terminate your stay with us.
